This data library has enabled anyone and everyone free access and download of numerous GIS layers from the County's GIS system.

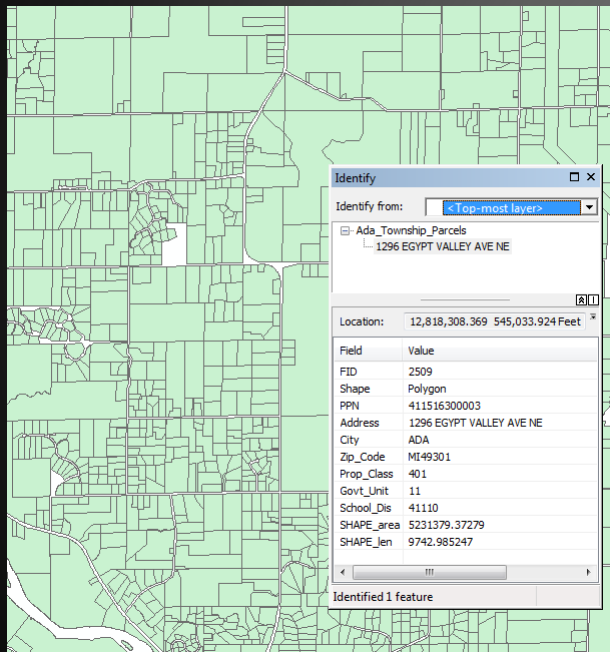
Some of the available layers are County parcels, hydrography, PLSS layers, City/Twp boundaries, school districts, and County parks.
