Over the past several years, the Land Bank has been utilizing geospatially referenced street level video to assist in the property condition inventory.

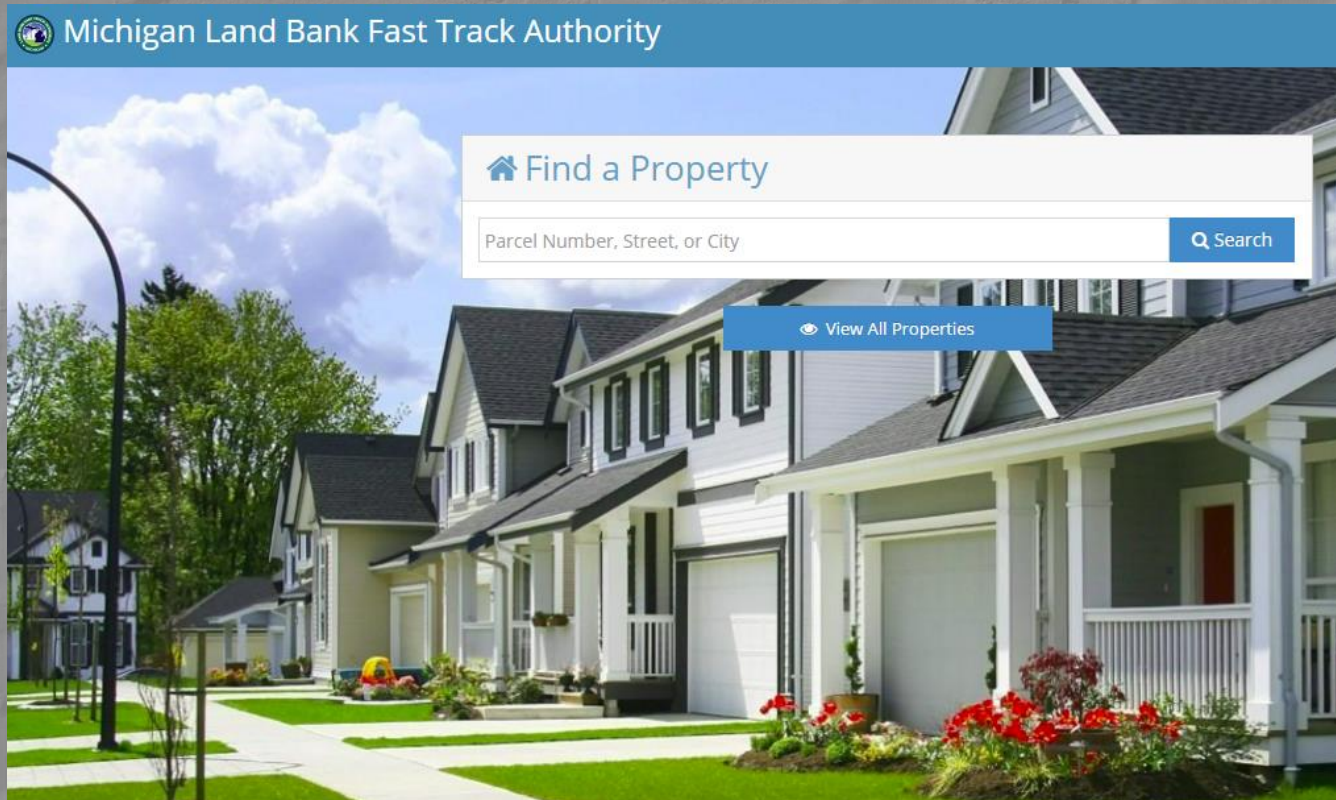
